

How to register with the Lawn Tennis Association (LTA) and opt-in to the Club's Wimbledon Ballot

Benefits of registering for British Tennis Membership with the LTA

We recommend you follow the quick and easy joining process to become a British Tennis Member as there are a range of benefits on offer, not least the opportunity to enter your Club's Wimbledon Ballot. This is really important as our club depends on its members to **OPT IN** in order to get our allocation of Wimbledon Tickets. The more members that **OPT IN**, the more tickets we are allocated so the more chance you have of being offered tickets via the ballot. Members are eligible from the age of 11 years.

You'll be contacted in late-2024 about arrangements for the Wimbledon 2025 ballot for club members, once more information becomes available. The Ballot for 2024 is now closed.
